### INTRODUCTION

The Western Wood Preservers Institute represents the pressure treated wood industry in western North America. WWPI provides educational information to assist consumers in the selection and proper, safe and environmentally appropriate use of treated wood products.

### ASSURANCE OF QUALITY

The American Lumber Standards Committee (ALSC) is responsible for the oversight and accreditation of third party inspection agencies for treated wood. In order to comply with all building codes, treated wood must be marked with the quality stamp or end tag of an accredited ALSC agency.

The International Building Code reads: "Wood required by Section 2304.11 to be preservative treated shall bear the quality mark of an inspection agency that maintains continuing supervision, testing and inspection over the quality of the preservative treated wood. Inspection agencies for preservative-treated wood shall be listed by an accreditation body\* that complies with the requirements of the American Lumber Standards Treated Wood Program, or equivalent. The quality mark shall be on a stamp or label affixed to preservative-treated wood."

Quality marks for treated wood are sometimes confusing with much product information including proprietary brands, warranties, etc. WWPI has implemented the CheckMark Identification Program to help users easily recognize and distinguish ALSC accredited agency's trademarks. Look for the CheckMark on the stamp or end-tag to quickly find the ALSC accredited agency's logo.



The industry also makes products for non-code applications that do not require ALSC oversight. Such products include landscape timbers for non-structural applications and decking products which carry their own manufacturer's warranty.

### ENVIRONMENTAL CODE

Members of WWPI share the public concern for a sound economy, healthy environment and good stewardship of all natural resources. WWPI's Environmental Code focuses on: the production of high quality products; operating facilities in a manner which meets or exceeds applicable regulations; supporting research to develop consumer and environmentally friendly products and processes; support scientifically appropriate standards and regulations; and proper disposal including recycling and reuse.

### BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES

The industry has developed additional guidelines (BMPs) for the production and use of treated wood products intended for use in aquatic or other sensitive environments. The BMPs are intended to minimize the potential for movement of preservatives into the environment. The program calls for third party certification provided in writing or by the presence of the BMP quality Mark. - 6 = PTI – Propiconazole Tebuconazole Imidacloprid

- 8 = Creosote & Creosote Petroleum Solutions
- 9 = Pentachlorophenol
- 10 = Solubilized Copper-8-Quinolinolate
